I. Life <u>can</u> be and <u>will</u> be hard.


James 1:2-3 ESV

2 Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, 3 for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness.









When life is hard remember:

- -God isn't punishing you.
- -God isn't failing you.
- -God hasn't abandoned you.
- -God won't answer every question for you.

That you may be perfect (mature) and complete, lacking in nothing.


- II. While you are in a trial ask these questions.
 - 2. What should I be learning?

Romans 5:3-4 ESV
3 Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, 4 and endurance produces character, and character produces hope.

- II. While you are in a trial, ask these questions.
 - 2. What should I be learning?
 - 1 Peter 1:6-7a NLT
 - 6 So be truly glad. There is wonderful joy ahead, even though you must endure many trials for a little while. 7 These trials will show that your faith is genuine.

- II. While you are in a trial ask these questions.
 - 3. Am I seeking help from the correct source.

James 1:5 ESV
5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.





III. In the mist of temptation.

1. Recognize the source.

Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God," for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one.

2. <u>Understand</u> the process.


James 1:14-15 ESV

But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. 15 Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death.

 - 3. Learn to overcome it.

I Cor. 10:13 ESV

No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it.
