In the eighteenth year of his reign, after he had purified the land and the Temple, Josiah appointed Shaphan son of Azaliah, Maaseiah the governor of Jerusalem, and Joah son of Joahaz, the royal historian, to repair the Temple of the Lord his God.

<sup>9</sup> They gave Hilkiah the high priest the money that had been collected by the Levites who served as gatekeepers at the Temple of God.

They restored what earlier kings of Judah had allowed to fall into ruin.

Then Hilkiah gave the scroll to Shaphan.
