The theological words for brand spanking new are the words <u>regeneration</u> and <u>sanctification</u>.



REGENERATION

is the work of God in your heart at the moment of salvation. God gives us a new life, a new heart and we are a new creation.

SANCTIFICATION

is the progressive work of <u>God</u> and <u>us</u> that makes us more and more free from sin and like Christ in our actual lives.
