

Paul's "honey do" list







We can only stand firm when we are in the <u>Lord</u>; any other place is not a <u>secure</u> place to stand.





Whatever the dispute was about, Euodia and Syntyche had forgotten that they have a greater common ground in Jesus Christ. They forgot that everything else was less important than that common ground.





Paul's joy wasn't based in a sunny optimism or positive mental attitude as much as it was the <u>confidence</u> that God was in <u>control</u>. It really was a joy in the Lord.





Paul used an interesting ancient Greek word here, *epieikeia*. It can be translated as gentleness, unselfishness, kindness, patience, moderation and graciousness.



It describes a person who is really **free** to let go of their anxieties and all the things that **cause** them stress, because they know that the **Lord** will take up their cause.





This is a command, not an <u>option</u>. Undue care is an intrusion into an arena that belongs to God alone. It makes us the <u>father</u> of the household instead of being a <u>child</u>.
