And we thought his troubles were a punishment from God, a punishment for his own sins!


⁵ But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins.








THE SERIOUSNESS OF HIS **PLEA** IS EVIDENCED AT THE SIGHT OF HIS **POSTURE**

²⁵A woman in the crowd had suffered for twelve years with constant bleeding. ²⁶She had suffered a great deal from many doctors, and over the years she had spent everything she had to pay them, but she had gotten no better. In fact, she had gotten worse. ²⁷She had heard about Jesus, so she

came up behind him through the crowd and touched his robe. ²⁸For she thought to herself, "If I can just touch his robe, I will be healed." ²⁹Immediately the bleeding stopped, and she could feel in her body that she had been healed of her terrible condition.

The child isn't dead; she's only asleep."
